\$1,000 - <u>Hardin County Skills</u> - to assist Hardin County Skills, Inc. in its efforts to provide services to the mentally and physically disabled citizens of our city and county

\$1,000 - <u>Retired Senior Volunteer Program</u> - to help defray transportation costs making it possible for the approximate 300 RSVP volunteers to contribute their talents, abilities and experience to the non-profit Hardin County agencies to whom they donate their services

In addition to the above organizations, the City of Savannah has appropriated funds for the following NONPROFIT organizations for its Fiscal Year 2018/2019:
