Precautionary Boil Water Notice

Due to a recent water line relocation, water customers located in the following service area:

Affected area: Gant Lane_____

a **Precautionary Boil Water Notice** is being issued to all customers in the affected area. Until further notice, water customers in these areas are advised to boil their water prior to using it for drinking or food preparation. As a precaution, customers should take the following steps:

1. Prior to boiling, the water should be strained through a clean cloth to remove any sediment or floating material.
2. The water should then be heated to a vigorous boil, and the rolling boil should be for one minute to insure disinfection.

The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, Division of Water Resources in the Jackson Environmental Field Office and Nashville, TN have been notified and made aware of this situation and this Precautionary Boil Water Notice.
