Sealed proposals for a **Cathodic Protection Survey** will include a cathodic protection survey on approximately 111 miles of coated steel gas mains and approximately 1,724 steel service lines. Savannah Utility Department is a municipally owned gas system located in Savannah, Tennessee. The gas distribution system consists of 296 miles of main line and approximately 7,503 service lines. A final report will be required as detailed in the RFP. This project is in Hardin County, Tennessee.
